2020 RVQ State Titles

Conditions of Nomination

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1. Definitions

Competition	The different choices of team composition that players have to choose from (Under 19's/Open/Over 35's/Over 45's - Mens/Ladies/Mixed)
Division	The competition is split into skill related divisions if needed at the committee's discretion
Permanent Player	A player who is going to play for the whole tournament
Substitute player	A player who is able to replace a permanent player who is unable to play for part of the tournament
Membership Fee	The \$20 fee that gives you RVQ membership for that calendar year
Tournament Team Nomination Fee	The \$60 administration fee to nominate for an RVQ Tournament
Tournament Team Game Fee	The fee to compete in an RVQ tournament (price varies per Tournament. Please see RVQ website for more details)
Calendar Year	1 st of January to 31 st of December of the current year

2. **Tournament Format**

2.1. Competitions & Divisions

Rebound Volleyball Queensland (RVQ) Tournaments may consist of the following 2.1.1. competitions (subject to team nominations):

Junior Mens (Under 19's)	Teams must consist a minimum of 4 and a maximum of 8 male players.
Code: JM	 Players must be 18 years of age or younger on the 1st of January 2020 to participate in the competition.
Open Mens	Teams must consist a minimum of 4 and a maximum of 8 male
Code: M	No age restrictions
Mens Masters (Over 35's)	Teams must consist a minimum of 4 and a maximum of 8 male players.
Code: MM	 Players must be 35 years of age or older by the 31st of December 2020 to participate in the competition.
Mens Grand Masters (Over 45's)	Teams must consist a minimum of 4 and a maximum of 8 male players.
Code: MGM	 Players must be 45 years of age or older by the 31st of December 2020 to participate in the competition.
Junior Ladies (Under 19's)	Teams must consist a minimum of 4 and a maximum of 8 female players.
Codes: JL	 Players must be 18 years of age or younger on the 1st of January 2020 to participate in the competition.
Open Ladies	Teams must consist a minimum of 4 and a maximum of 8 female
Code: L	players.No age restrictions
Ladies Masters (Over 35's)	Teams must consist a minimum of 4 and a maximum of 8 female players.
Code: LM	 Players must be 35 years of age or older by the 31st of December 2020 to participate in the competition.

Ladies Grand Masters (Over 45's)	Teams must consist a minimum of 4 and a maximum of 8 female players.
Code: LGM	 Players must be 45 years of age or older by the 31st of December 2020 to participate in the competition.
Junior Mixed (Under 19's)	 Teams must consist a minimum of 4 (cannot be 4 males) players and a maximum of 10 (5 males and 5 females) players. Players must be 18 years of age or younger on the 1st of
Code: JMX	January 2020 to participate in the competition.
Open Mixed	• Teams must consist a minimum of 4 (cannot be 4 males) players and a maximum of 10 (5 males and 5 females) players.
Code: MX	No age restrictions
Mixed Masters (Over 35's)	• Teams must consist a minimum of 4 (cannot be 4 males) players and a maximum of 10 (5 males and 5 females) players.
Code: MXM	 Players must be 35 years of age or older by the 31st of December 2020 to participate in the competition.
Mixed Grand Masters (Over 45's)	• Teams must consist a minimum of 4 (cannot be 4 males) players and a maximum of 10 (5 males and 5 females) players.
Code: MXGM	 Players must be 45 years of age or older by the 31st of December 2020 to participate in the competition.

- 2.1.2. The Competitions within the Tournament are a 6 aside format.
- 2.1.3. All teams must have a minimum of 5 players registered with a minimum of 4 players taking the court.
- 2.1.4. Mixed Team must ALWAYS have 1 female player on court. The minimum of 4 players taking the court can consist of 3 males and 1 female, 2 males & 2 females, 1 male & 3 females or 4 females.
- 2.1.5. For a competition to be formed there must be at least 2 teams competing in the competition. If there are less than 2 teams competing, then the nominating team/s will be given the option to enter another competition if available (eg – if there is only 1 Men's Masters team entered, then they will be given the option to play in the Open Men's competition).

2.2. Rules

RVQ rules differ to indoor volleyball and beach volleyball. All players are expected to familiarise themselves with these rules prior to taking the court. A copy of the rules can be obtained from the RVQ website.

2.3. Uniform Policy

- 2.3.1. All teams are encouraged to wear their club's official uniform with the club's logo.
- 2.3.2. The club uniforms are set by their club. For information about club uniforms, teams should contact the Club's Centre Manager.

3. Membership

3.1. RVQ Membership

- 3.1.1. To participate at RVQ's State Titles Tournament, a player must be a "current" RVQ registered member in the 2020 calendar year.
- 3.1.2. To become a member of RVQ:
 - 1. Go onto the RVQ website (www.rvq.com.au)
 - 2. Complete the online "*RVQ Membership Application*" Form prior to Friday the 25th of September.
 - 3. Transfer the \$20 RVQ Membership fee to the RVQ bank account prior to Friday the 25th of September 2020. Please include your full name as the payment reference to ensure your RVQ membership is processed correctly.

4. STATE TITLES 2020 Team Nomination

To limit the number of people within the venue, RVQ has decided that each player may only compete in 1 competition. This can be EITHER Mens/Ladies OR Mixed competition.

4.1 Nomination Process

For your team to be able to participate in the 2020 RVQ State Titles:

- 1. Contact your centre manager with an expression of interest for your team to compete.
- 2. Centre managers are responsible for choosing and nominating the teams which will represent their centre.
 - Each centre's quota is comprised of a maximum of:
 - 2x Junior Men's
 - 2x Junior Ladies
 - 2x Open Men's
 - 2x Open Ladies
 - 2x Men's Masters
 - 2x Ladies Masters
 - 3x Junior Mixed
 - 3x Open Mixed
 - 3x Mixed Masters

- Once your centre manager has decided and approved of your team being able to compete, they will submit your team's Nomination Form to RVQ on your behalf. It is the team captain's responsibility to pay for the team's fees to secure your position.
- 4. RVQ must receive all team payments and team nomination forms prior to Friday the 25th of September.
- 5. Once RVQ has received the team payment and the team nomination form, RVQ will issue the team captain with their team's playing code.
- 6. Each Men's & Ladies team can nominate a maximum of 8 players. Mixed teams can nominate a maximum of 5 male and 5 female players.

5. Payment

5.1. Payment Options

- 5.1.1. Team game fee payment of \$300 and team registration fee payment of \$60 totalling \$360 for **RVQ's 2020 State Titles** must be paid in full by Friday the 25th of September 2020 via a single electronic payment. When making the payment, please use the team captain's full name as the payment reference.

6. Competition Format

6.1. Matches

- 6.1.1. All Friday and Saturday matches will be a round robin format, where each team will compete against all other teams in their competition. Sunday will be Finals.
- 6.1.2. Each match will be a timed game of 2 halves with continuous scoring. Golden Point will be played for all drawn games in the Round Robin Matches.
- 6.1.3. Umpire duties may be performed by paid umpires. RVQ reserves the right to request playing teams to perform team umpiring duties, if necessary.
- 6.1.4. There will be a small break between each match.
- 6.1.5. At Finals, if there is a draw at the end of the scheduled time, an additional two minutes of game time will be played. If teams are still tied, the game will go to Golden Point.

6.2. Leaderboard

- 6.2.1. Competition points are awarded as follows:
 - Winning team receives 3 points;
 - Losing team receives 1 point;
 - Bonus points are earnt for every multiple of 10 match points scored (irrespective of win or loss);
 - · Forfeit or disqualification receive 0 points;
- 6.2.2. Team competition points will be accumulated daily and shown on a leaderboard. If teams have equal total points, then the team with the highest win points will receive a higher ranking.
- 6.2.3. The leaderboard will be updated after the completion of each day. It will be emailed out to all players, updated on our website and posted on Facebook and Instagram.

6.3. Finals

- 6.3.1. Matches during the finals day will be a double elimination format and all teams will have had the opportunity to make the finals.
- 6.3.2. A player must have played a minimum of 1 full day for their team and have signed the attendance sheet to be eligible for finals.

7. **COVID Safety Procedures**

- With the evolving situation, further safety procedures may be implemented in line with the current QLD Government rulings at the time of the event. These changes will be communicated with attendees prior to and during the event.
- The venue has a COVID Safe Plan and will be professionally cleaned and sanitised prior to State Titles.
- If you are unwell, including but not limited to having the sniffles, sore throat or cough, you should not attend.
- Each person, players and non-players, will need to complete an attendance record with their entry and exit times as required by QLD COVID guidelines.
- Upon entry to the venue, everyone MUST use the hand sanitiser provided. You are encouraged to sanitise regularly.
- Social distancing of 1.5m is to be adhered to as much as is practical.
- Spectators are not actively encouraged to attend this event, as suggested by QLD COVID guidelines. This is to ensure that patronage is less than the maximum allowable for this size venue, allowing 4m² minimum per person.
- Each club will be allocated an area where their teams will be expected to return to when not playing on court.

- The Mens and Ladies competitions will be played separately from the Mixed competitions. There will be a scheduled interval to minimise the crossover between Mens and Ladies attendees and the Mixed attendees.
- Playing balls will be sanitised regularly and RVQ will not be lending any out for warmups.
- Please refrain from touching/hi-fiving/backslapping other players in celebration, during the half time changeover or at the conclusion of the game.
- Captains will not need to sign the umpire score sheet but will need to sight the final score. They will then let the umpire know they are happy with the final score and will sign on the captains behalf.
- If purchasing food or beverages at the venue, they are to be consumed at your club's designated area.
- Anyone deliberately/repeatedly ignoring guidelines may be asked to leave the venue.
